



**Agreement on Master's Degree, Program with Two Diplomas between
Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Czech
Republic
and the Department of Mechanical Engineering at National Chung Hsing
University, Taiwan**

Based on the terms set out in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Czech Technical University in Prague (CTU), **Czech Republic** and National Chung Hsing University (NCHU), Taiwan, CTU and NCHU agree to implement the following requirements for the Master's degree program with two diplomas.

1. CTU, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and the Department of Mechanical Engineering at NCHU agree to implement the "Master's Degree with Two diplomas", hereinafter referred to as the "Program", for Master students of both institutions.
2. During the implementation term of the Program, students can apply for the Program complying with the regulations given by both universities. The registration, duration of study and the academic status must be managed by the home institution.
3. Students participating in the Program should have a bachelor's degree (BSc., Bc. or equivalent).
4. Prerequisites for Language Proficiency
 - (1) Students of NCHU are required to submit one of the following documents to CTU, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering before their enrollments.
 - (a) A score of TOEFL-CBT no less than 168
 - (b) A score of TOEFL-IBT no less than 61
 - (c) Any other test of equivalent score
 - (d) A Czech proficiency certificate issued by CTU
 - (e) A letter of recommendation which guarantees the applicant of a sufficient level to attend classes at CTU
 - (2) Students of CTU are required to submit one of the following documents to the Department of Mechanical Engineering at NCHU before their enrollments.
 - (a) A score of TOEFL-CBT no less than 168
 - (b) A score of TOEFL-IBT no less than 61
 - (c) Any other test of equivalent score
 - (d) A Chinese proficiency certificate issued by NCHU
 - (e) A letter of recommendation which guarantees the applicant of a sufficient level to attend classes at NCHU
5. To earn the Master's degree with two diplomas from both universities, participating students must fulfill the following requirements:
 - (1) Fulfill the number of accredited courses of the Master study program required by both institutions. The number of accredited courses will be constituents of each individual curriculum approved by both universities.


- (2) Complete the approved number of semesters at both universities. The number of semesters and the place of completion will be constituents of each individual curriculum approved by both universities. The student must complete a total of at least four semesters.
6. The courses taken by the students must fulfill the requirements of the accredited programs offered by the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering at CTU and the Department of Mechanical Engineering at NCHU. The official transcript will be reported to the faculty/department at the end of each semester.
7. To be granted the Master's Degree with Two Diplomas from both universities, participating students must fulfill one of the following requirements
- (1) Master's thesis defense at NCHU and the State Examination at CTU,
 - (2) Master's thesis defense and the State Examination at CTU,

An official statement must be reported to the faculty/department of both universities when the student has passed the above-mentioned examination(s). At least one member of the partner faculty/department must be included in the thesis common committee and must be present at the thesis defense.


8. This agreement shall become effective on the date of signing and be valid until the Agreement on Double Degree Program concluded between CTU and NCHU is terminated. Any issue not covered in this agreement will be decided upon by CTU, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and the Department of Mechanical Engineering at NCHU through mutual discussion.




